Churchmanship: Choosy Children Choose Chocolate

OBJECTIVE:

To teach the important lesson that Choosy Children Choose Church. Through the art of play and activity, this activity will show how important it is to be involved in the life of a church.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

Chocolate Bar Chomp Skit (to perform for your Sunday School Class)

Prop: Your favorite candy bar.

(Pick up the candy bar and slowly unwrap it. While you are unwrapping it, present the following conversation)

"This is my favorite candy bar. I can hardly wait to get it open and eat it."

(Take a bite.)

"Um! Umm! Um! That is so good. By the way, what are your favorite candy bars?"

(While they answer say, "Um! Umm! Um!" a few times After they have given the answers...)

"Would any of you like a bite of this?"

(Lick the top.)

"Oh I guess not."

"What I have done is kind of like some people are when it comes to their church. They eat the candy bar (go to church) and don't share it with their friends and neighbors. Let's not keep church to ourselves; let's share how good God is!"



Game: Chocolate Scramble

You'll need: a pair of mittens and three (3) candy bars.

Sit in a circle on the floor. Put a candy bar in the center of the circle.

1. Take turns rolling the dice until someone rolls a six (6).
2. The first to roll a six (6) must put on mittens, runs around the circle, and must eat the candy bar.
3. As they attempt to complete the task, other players continue to roll. If another player rolls a six (6), they must try to get ahead of the player who has already put on the mittens.
4. The winner is the one who completes the tasks and eats the candy bar.
