Relationship With God: Intercessory Prayer

According to www.m-w.com (Merriam-Webster Online Dictionary), **INTERCESSION** means: “prayer, petition, or entreaty (plea) in favor of another.” In other words, when you pray **FOR ANOTHER** person and **ASK** God to **ANSWER THEIR PRAYER REQUEST** you are praying an **INTERCESSORY PRAYER**.

OBJECTIVE:

To learn...

- God always answers prayer in the way He sees best.
- He works in response to the prayers of His children.
- He may not answer in the way we expect but He always answers.
- About our responsibility to pray for other Christians.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

1. Ask three (3) people for a personal prayer request (intercessory prayer).
2. Write (with the help of your mentor) requests in a journal or notebook.
3. Go on a prayer walk in your backyard. Walk and pray for the requests you recorded in your journal.
 - Sit, stand, or kneel as you pray.
 - Stop in different places as you walk.
 - ⇒ Stop under a tree to pray for one person
 - ⇒ Sit in a lawn chair and pray for the next request
 - ⇒ Find a place to kneel as you pray for the final request
4. Pray every day that God will take care of each person's prayer request in His best way.
5. Pray every day that God will show them how much He loves and cares for them.
6. Each week check in with the person you prayed for to ask them what God has done for them and the situation you have been praying about.
7. In your journal, record what happens when you pray for others. Write specific answers to your prayers. Ask your mentor if you need help.
