Learning About Missions: All Around the World at Once

OBJECTIVE:

This activity allows teens to experience missions through the children's missions books.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

Read the three advanced Children's missionary books. If you don't know where to find the books, talk to the NMI president at your church, who should be able to help you. (The three advanced books won't say "Advanced" on the cover, but they will be thicker than the other ones. If these books are too easy for you to read, pick out an adult missionary book to read instead.)

After reading all 3 books, choose one to refer to when answering the following questions:

1. What did you learn about missions from this book?
2. What did you learn about God from this book?
3. Could you relate/connect to anything you read about?
4. Is there anything you learned about, that could help you in the future as a missionary?
5. Is there someone you can recommend this book to? If so, who?

When you have answered all of these questions, get together with your mentor to discuss the book and your answers to the questions.
