Learning About Missions: Bottles of All Shapes & Sizes

OBJECTIVE:

To show that though people may differ in outward appearance, all are in need of salvation through Jesus Christ.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

Missionaries go to all kinds of people to spread the good news about Jesus. No matter what a person looks like on the outside, all have the same need of Jesus on the inside.

Choose a picture of a person your mentor has given you and study it. After looking at the way the person in the picture is dressed, decorate a water bottle to look like that person.

Use supplies such as:

- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- Eyes (Can be found in craft stores)
- Scraps of Cloth (for skin tones)
- Yarn (For hair)

After you have finished decorating the water bottle, glue a Styrofoam ball onto the top of each bottle. Pull some fabric over the ball and secure it with glue. Complete the face by gluing wiggly eyes and drawing a nose, mouth, ears, etc. Make clothes for the person (body of the bottle) out of different colored fabric scraps. After the head is in place, put hair on the top to finish. Your mentor might need to help you in this process.

As you complete this project, remember: no matter where we come from or what we look like, everyone needs to know about Jesus. He loves “bottles of all shapes and sizes”. God loves us and wants us to know about Jesus, no matter what we look like. Missionaries are part of God’s plan to spread the good news of Jesus to people from every culture
