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## Learning About Missions: Loving your LINKS

### OBJECTIVE:

To provide an opportunity for children to interact with missionaries and missionary kids and gain insight into a missionary's life.

### DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

**LINKS** is a program in the Nazarene church, which means:

Loving  
Interested  
Nazarenes  
Knowing and  
Sharing



Every North American district is given the name of a missionary family or families to pray for. Each district has the opportunity to send letters and care packages to remind the missionaries they are loved and prayed for by other Christians.

In order to discover how your life is the same as or different from the life of an MK, follow the instructions below.

1. Find out from your church's Nazarene Missions International (NMI) president about your LINKS missionary family.
2. Ask for the e-mail or postal address for the family or individual.
3. If your LINKS missionary family has children, write a letter or an e-mail to the MKs. Tell them about what life is like here, for you; ask them questions about what life is like for them (school, house, city/town, hobbies, weekend activities, amount of homework). Ask them how you can support them and their family as they minister overseas (prayer, Sunday School supplies, Vacation Bible School supplies, school supplies, food they miss)
4. When the MK responds or missionary writes back to you, have a parent help you put together a care package for them. Remember to pray for them as you send the package.
5. Talk to your mentor about what you have learned by loving your LINKS missionaries.
