World Awareness: What's Up in the World?

OBJECTIVE:

To find out what is going on in the world around us. And to learn what makes God smile and what makes Him sad.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

1. Before beginning your activity, pray. Ask God to help you see the world through His eyes. Ask Him to help you learn what He wants you to.
2. Take time to watch a national news program on TV or read a newspaper or magazine article about events in another country. Be sure your selection covers more than local news, but also things happening across the country and around the world.
3. Write your answers to the following questions on the form included with this activity:
 - What is going on in the place I am learning about?
 - What is happening to people and how are they feeling in the country I am learning about?
 - Why is it happening?
 - Is this making God smile, or is this making God sad?
 - Is there anything I can do to help the people in this country?
 - Why is it important to know what is going on in other places?
 - How can I pray for this country and their people?
4. Pray for the people you just learned about. Ask God to be with them in their lives and in the situations they are facing.
5. Pretend you are a reporter on TV and “report” on the country you just learned about. Remember, this is a great opportunity for you to teach the kids in your church about the country and the people you just learned about. As you are planning what you will say, try to think of how you might tell your friends at church about the country you’ve been learning about.
6. Ask your children’s pastor if you can present the skit sometime in the next month. Have fun teaching your friends at church about the world area you just learned about yourself!
