



World Mission Broadcast Silent Announcement

Note: This announcement may be presented by all ages. It can be done live as described below; or if you choose, you can make a PowerPoint of the information and show it to the congregation before, during, and/or after services.

Purchase pieces of posterboard and print the following information on them, marking them numerically and listing "front" and "back" on the appropriate side. Depending on the size of your church, you may use half-size sheets or full sheets.

Board #1 Front: World Mission Broadcast
Board #1 Back: 2010 Statistics
Board #2 Front: 36 Languages
Board #2 Back: 72 Countries
Board #3 Front: 140 Programs
Board #3 Back: 7,012 Broadcasts
Board #4 Front: Yes, that is correct!
Board #4 Back: 7,012 Broadcasts!
Board #5 Front: \$4.00 to air one minute of the Gospel globally
Board #5 Back: That's right! \$4.00!
Board #6 Front: How many minutes will you support?
Board #6 Back: Offering Date: _____
Board #7 Front: World Mission Broadcast
Board #7 Back: Breaking Down Barriers



Ask seven* people help you promote the World Mission Broadcast Offering without saying anything. All they have to do is carry a sign.

On the day of the presentation, distribute the signs and have presenters stand in the order listed. Instruct the presenters to hold their signs chest high, so everyone in the church can see them. When it is time for the presentation, have the group go to the side of the platform, holding their signs so they cannot be seen. Each presenter walks to a prominent place on the platform, shows the front of the sign, counts (silently) to five slowly, shows the back of the sign, counts (silently) to five slowly, then walks down as the next presenter walks to the platform.

This should be done with no talking. If you have the technology available, a sound effect, such as radio static, could be used.

* Fewer people may be used by having them hold up multiple signs. They will pick up the next sign after exiting the platform, then take their place at the end of the line of presenters.
