

# ROLES OF PASTOR AND NMI PRESIDENT

## PASTOR

- ◆ Pray
  - ◆ Each mission emphasis
  - ◆ President and council
  - ◆ Missionaries
  - ◆ World needs
- ◆ Verbal Support
  - ◆ Recognize work of NMI in your report
  - ◆ Church meetings—make big deal over mission involvement and goals met
- ◆ Attend council meetings and give support/input to council
- ◆ Help promote World Evangelism Fund and all NMI work
  - ◆ Worship folder/newsletters
  - ◆ Prayer
  - ◆ Lead the way in participation
- ◆ Be enthusiastic
- ◆ Infuse missions in the life of the church
  - ◆ Songs, sermons, activities, pastoral prayer, missionaries on deputation
- ◆ Regularly communicate with President (dialog, brainstorm, plan, goal setting, strategize, reports), chair NMI nominating committee, President's report and election at church meeting
- ◆ Training—Help plan for and give opportunities
- ◆ Give president room to work—empower

## PRESIDENT

- ◆ General supervision of work of missions in church
- ◆ Plan, set goals; strategize with pastor and council
- ◆ Share your vision
- ◆ Communicate with district president, District Council, pastor, and church
- ◆ Plan mission events and emphases—delegate to council their responsibilities
- ◆ Promotion of NMI objectives, emphases, World Evangelism Fund, mission education, etc.
- ◆ Train pastor, council, and congregation
- ◆ Commit work to God
- ◆ Send reports
