**South America Region Prayer Requests**

***Región***

Prayer—For Nazarenes in Venezuela as they face social and political conditions. Pray that God will use this situation to advance the church and be an agent of hope and relief.

Prayer—For the evangelistic thrust "The Power of Prayer" where 1,000,000 people will be praying for 10,000,000 people every year (or 330,000 Nazarene praying for 10,000,000 three times per year) during the next three years in order to reach the 20/20 vision for the region.

Prayer—For the launching of the "I WIN" (Wesleyan Institute of Leadership and Nazarene Identity) initiative to train 20,000 developing leaders in the next four years.

Prayer—For the 100 "Living the Great Commission" churches as they mentor 300 new churches in holistic development.
