- ❖ Pray for those affected by the political unrest. In many areas of the world today, political unrest marginalizes and victimizes people. We pray for hope to rise in their lives and for the church to be ready to offer peace, hope, and love.
- ❖ Pray for those called to go to places where the church is not yet. Pray that the Lord of the Harvest will call many to go to the harvest field where the church is not yet present. As He calls, we will be faithful to encourage and support those He calls as they prepare, go, and serve.

\*An unreached or least-reached people is a people group among which there is no indigenous community of believing Christians with adequate number and resources to evangelize this people group without outside assistance.
