ROAM is a relatively new Nazarene Missions organization serving the United States. Its mission is to provide opportunities for members to travel and live in their RVs while serving Nazarene camps and churches by providing a labor of love. Check out this report from one camp.

"First, I want to tell you how great your crew was this September. The crew you sent, fit like a glove, they had the skills and experience that made the project(s) a success. The materials were there and God sent just the right people to us at Pinelow Camp, WA.

"Here's a list of all the things that were accomplished in those three short weeks. 18 cabins were painted inside and out, trim and siding were repaired, roofs were repaired, screen windows were made and installed, crawl space screens were built and installed. Overhead lighting that had not been working for many years was repaired and made operational again. What a blessing to us! The exterior of our well house was remodeled, and we even got a pole in the middle of one of our parking lots finally removed, this has been needed for many years and eliminates a traffic hazard from our facility. A trench was dug and water pipes laid in our challenge course area, this was huge for us, the roads had four to six inches of fine dust on them last summer and now we can prevent that from happening next year. Some of the ROAM people even donated funds to help finish some of the projects. Siding on our shop was installed.

I know I'm forgetting something but these were the highlights for us. We truly have come to depend on ROAM and your support. Pinelow desperately needed this partnership to survive!

"As for next year, we have two projects. One is a spring project the first two weeks of June ... to install a sprinkler system on the grounds. We lost most of the lawn around our Pineview lodges and would like to correct this by installing a sprinkler system... It would entail trenching and laying PVC pipe and installing risers and sprinklers as well as some minor electrical work to install the clocks, valves and other controls. Another project will be in September as we have done the past two years. This project includes repairing siding and painting the exterior of five major buildings."
