

Crisis Care Kit/School Pal-Pak Donations

Churches and individuals donated 44,330 Crisis Care Kits (CCKs) and 11,393 School Pal-Paks (SPPs) by submitting them to the two main warehouses and sending the storage and shipping costs to Global Treasury Services (GTS). Those districts with the highest percentage of participation by church (not including those churches that combined their CCKs/SPPs under the district's name) are:

- West Virginia North—30 of 51 churches participating (58.8%)
- Northwest Indiana—27 of 50 churches participating (54%)
- Pittsburgh—43 of 84 churches participating (51.2%)
- New England—46 of 91 churches participating (50.5%)
- North Carolina—28 of 58 churches participating (48.2%)
- Philadelphia—25 of 53 churches participating (47.1%)
- Michigan—33 of 72 churches participating (45.8%)
- Southwest Indiana—36 of 80 churches participating (45%)
- Southwestern Ohio—32 of 71 churches participating (45%)
- Northeastern Indiana—33 of 74 churches participating (44.6%)

- Indianapolis—25 out of 59 churches participating (42.4%)
- East Ohio—32 out of 77 churches participating (41.6%)
- West Virginia South—25 of 62 churches participating (40.3%)

Note: Only those CCKs/SPPs with funds submitted through GTS are included in this list. When churches ship boxes directly to a disaster location and do not send the funds through GTS, those churches are responsible for providing numbers to those districts that need them.
