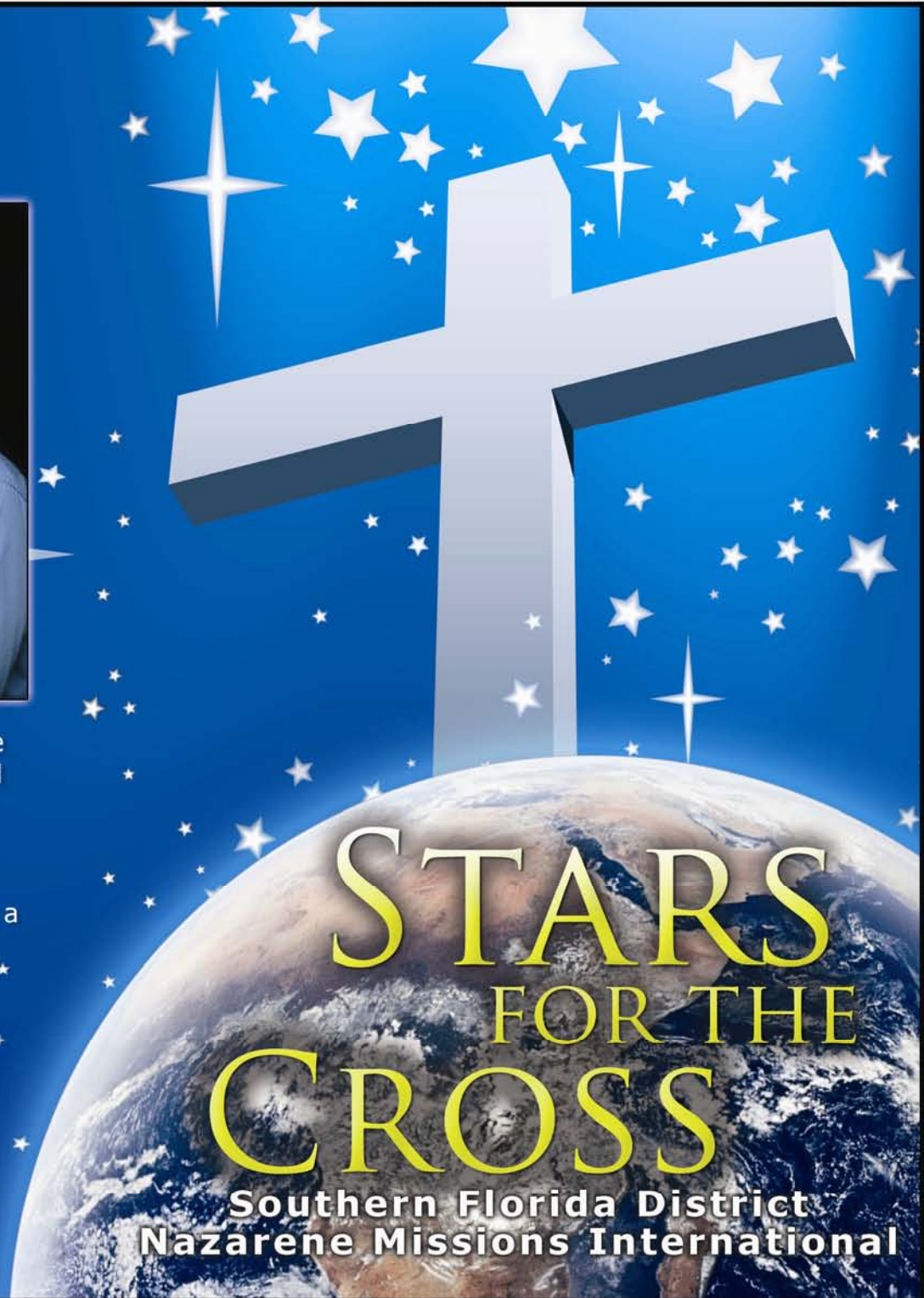

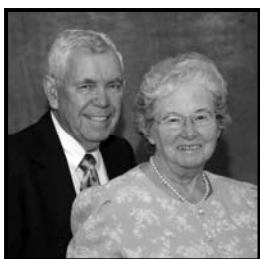
Dr. Ken & Linda Walker

Rev. Ardee & Faith Coolidge

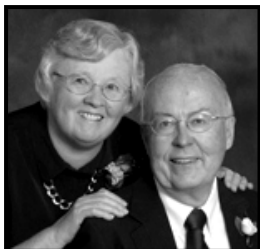

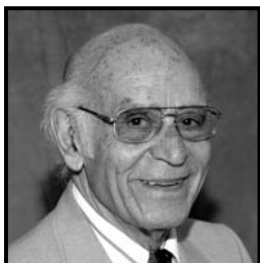
Ms. Mary Miller

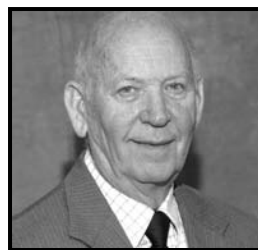
