JFHP – 11 Million Decisions

Nazarene JESUS Film teams have reported 60,674,207 evangelistic contacts* from January 1998 through February 2012. Of these contacts, 11,006,818 (18.1% of contacts) have indicated decisions for Christ with 4,181,508 (38.0% of decisions) initial discipleship follow-ups. There have been 30,168 preaching points started.

PNG Ferry Accident

An inter-island ferry thought to be carrying around 350 people, 80% of them students about to start college or university, has sunk 16 km off the eastern coast of Papua New Guinea (PNG). By Thursday night, 238 individuals had been rescued with another 110 still missing. Initial indications are that some Melanesia Nazarene Bible College students coming from our Nuigini Islands district may have been on board. Field Strategy Coordinator Harmon Schmelzenbach and Church leaders are trying to obtain clear information. Please pray for the ongoing rescue operations and the families and communities affected by this tragedy.

Today's group for NMI's prayer emphasis for unreached people groups from the Joshua Project* is:

Mongol of China

The Mongols, who consist of as many as sixty separate Mongolian tribes, are one of China's official nationalities. Through thousands of bitter winters the Mongols have lived in yurts (portable, tent-like homes also called "gers"), racing their horses, raising livestock, and worshipping the forces of nature. There are almost six million Mongols scattered across a wide area of northern China. Approximately three times as many Mongols live in China as in the nation of Mongolia. There has been significant debates over how many are believers in Christ. Regardless, ask the Lord to reveal his love and truth to this people group. Pray that many will hear and receive eternal life through Jesus Christ.

*The Joshua Project is a research initiative seeking to highlight the ethnic people groups with the least followers of Jesus Christ.
