**Papua New Guinea Ferry**

Thank you for praying last week for people who were on a ferry that sank in Papua New Guinea (PNG). No Melanesia Nazarene Bible College (MNBC) students were on the ferry. Harmon Schmelzenbach, field strategy coordinator, reports that MNBC and district leaders have been contacted and "unbelievably the indication is that for some unknown reason all of the MNBC students who were scheduled to be on the ferry that day did not get on the ship. The information we have is that no MNBC students died in this tragedy!" Thank you for praying. Ask God to shower his grace and comfort on the family and friends of the people who perished in this accident.

**Vanuatu Vehicle**

In January missionaries David and Sylvia Potter asked us to pray for a vehicle that would be used in their ministry. Last Thursday, February 2, a Hyundai Galloper II was purchased and signed over to the Church of the Nazarene for the missionaries' use in Vanuatu. Praise the Lord for His provision.

**JFHP – 11 Million Decisions**

Nazarene JESUS Film teams reported 60,674,207 evangelistic contacts from January 1998 through February 2012. Of these contacts, 11,006,818 (18.1 percent of contacts) have indicated decisions for Christ with 4,181,508 (38.0 percent of decisions) initial discipleship follow-ups. There have been 30,168 preaching points started.
